Camera movement	Camera movement is varied and often smooth. Not all handheld.

Cut-on action	One or more sequences have several shots that cut seamlessly "on action" between angles in continuity style.		
Finished Quality	Film stands alone with an "ease-in" and out –probably from black– for watchability. Title and credits unnecessary, but aid professional feel. Let the beginning and end breathe.		
Precision & Care	Film shows evidence of careful planning and deliberate setups. Doesn't feel like you just "pointed and shot" the footage, but followed a plan. 1.5- 4ish minutes		
Sound	No "drop-outs" in sound. Soundtrack fades out at end for audience ease. Changes in sound are deliberate, smooth and professional.
